**Class Placement** What you can do at this time with few or no falls.

- New skier** - no skiing experience.
- Beginning skier** - can go straight and stop. Some turning. Needs help on the beginner chairlift hill. Green Circle runs.
- Wedge turn skier** - links wedge turns. Skis independently on the beginner chairlift hill. Green Circle & some Blue Square runs
- Christie skier** - can sideslip both ways. Finishes last half of turn with matched skis. All Blue Square & some Black Diamond runs
- Carving skier** - can match skis in most turns with pole plants. Skis most advanced slopes. All Black Diamond runs
- ATAC skier** - skis all terrain and all snow conditions including, deep snow, moguls and Double Black Diamond runs.
